Driving at Lawrence North is a privilege and not a right. You must abide by the guidelines established for LN. All cars must have a valid permit displayed on the rear view mirror. Students will not be allowed to park unless the permit is visible. **All students must park in the back of the school. There will be no reserved parking spaces. Students may park in any student designated space in the back lot. All cars must be removed from the band practice lot by 4:00 pm each day, August-November. Violators are subject to towing at owner's expense.**

Please read the following expectations.

1. Students will follow all safe-driving rules and practices as established by the State of Indiana and Lawrence North High School. The speed limit on school property is **10 mph** at all times.
2. Upon arrival to school, students will immediately park in a designated **parking space**. Students park only in the **west** lot. All other parking areas are off limits unless an administrator gives special permission.
3. Students will not park in the Marion County Public Library lot or on neighborhood streets.
4. Students will not sit on their cars or be allowed to visit their cars during school hours unless an administrator gives permission.
5. Student's cars may be searched for disciplinary reasons. Students will be given a reasonable opportunity to be present during the search.
6. **Students drive to school at their own risk. The school does not provide insurance, nor is it liable for damages that happen to a car while on school property.** All students must have a valid driver's license (not a permit) and be covered by their own insurance. Any accident that occurs on school property should be reported to security and school administration within one (1) day of the accident
7. Tardiness to school due to car related problems are unexcused. Excessive tardies to school could result in loss of driving privileges.
8. See Mr. Zeller or Mr. Penrose in the athletic office concerning any parking issues.

All parking spaces are \$40.00. Violations of these conditions may result in a loss of parking/driving privileges and/or fine. Lost or stolen parking tags are \$5.00 to replace. Please make checks out to Lawrence North High School.
